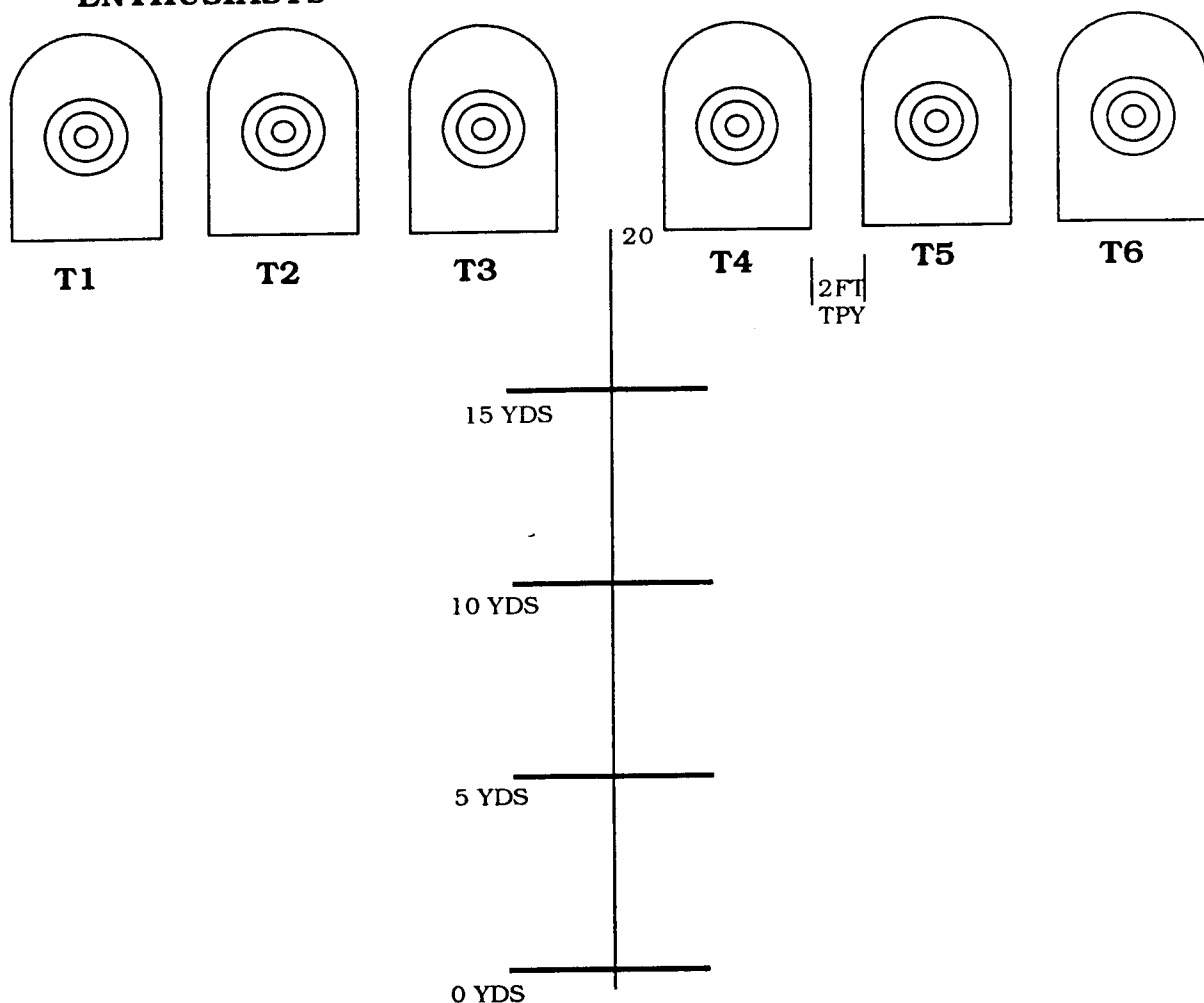

**CLASSIFIER 96-3  
FAST STANDARDS  
DESIGNER:**



**Start Position:** Standing behind 4' fault line, facing down range with hands naturally at sides.

**Stage Procedure:** All shooting must be done from directly behind 4' fault line. On each string engage each target with one round, in any order.

**String 1, 20 yards, PRONE:** On signal draw and then go prone, engage T1-T6 with one round each. Only forearms may extent beyond fault line.

**String 2 ,15 yards, KNEELING:** On signal, draw , kneel(1 or both knees must contact the ground, behind the fault line), and engage T1-T6 with one round each.

**String 3, 10 yards, STRONG HAND ONLY:** On signal draw and engage T1-T6, with one round each, strong hand only.

**String 4, 5 yards, WEAK HAND ONLY:** On signal draw with strong hand and tranfer to weak hand , engage T1-T6 with one round each, weak only.

**Target:** 6 paper

**Scoring:** Shot Count

**Min. Rounds:** 24

**Min. Distance:** 5 Yards

**Max. Distance:** 20 Yards

**Start Signal:** Audible

**Stop Signal:** Last Shot

**Penalties:**

Premature start	+5 seconds
Foot faults	+5 seconds
Extra shot/hit	+5 seconds
Each mandatory target not hit	+5 seconds
Procedures	+5 seconds

**Range set-up:** Target are sat to ground level per Rule Book, Faultlines are four feet wide.
