STARTING Position: For all three strings, Standing in box A, facing down range, with hands at sides.

STAGE PROCEDURE:

STRING 1

On the signal, draw and engage targets P1, P2, P3, & P4, in any order, with one hit each, then engage the stop plate with one hit, the stop plate must be engaged last.

STRING 2

Repeat string 1 procedure.

STRING 3

Repeat string 1 procedure.

All three string count for score.

TARGETS: 5 - 12" Round steel plates, if you don't have steel plates use paper plates

HITS PER TARGET: per string 1

SCORING: Comstock MIN. ROUNDS MIN. DISTANCE: 7 Yards MAX. DISTANCE: 11 Yards START SIGNAL: Audible STOP SIGNAL: Last Shot

PENALTIES: Premature start

Foot faults Misses
